

Richmond Heights City Council Public Hearing

The Public Hearing was opened by the Finance Director, Lynda Rossiter at 7:28 pm

Rossiter will be going out for a CDBG Grant and went over the possible amounts to receive, with \$150,000 being the maximum. If the City did receive this, then Marous Brothers has said that could amount to an additional 1000 square feet. This could add a new, expanded work force station and help out the Fire Dept.

In order to go out for the grant, the City will focus on 3 specific ideas:

- 1) This additional space could add a more diverse work force and allow the City to make an additional facility for female firefighters.
- 2) Additional administration staff could be added for the Fire Dept.
- 3) This space could allow for a Training Community Room, with larger and better equipment to help the community.

Hunt added that the purposes of this Public Hearing is to allow the audience/public to propose anything else that they may like to add.

Rossiter opened the floor for discussion and suggestions.
