Runway Rehabilitation/Reconstruction Begins at Airport on Wednesday, May 31

As part of the Phase 2 renovations of the [Cuyahoga County Airport](#), Runway 6/24 rehabilitation/resurfacing will begin on Wednesday, May 31.
