## Richmond Town Square

Dealpoint Merrill, owner of the building and developer of the former Macy's department store at Richmond Town Square has begun construction for a "Class A" heated and air-conditioned self-storage facility. They plan to invest \$9.9 million to create 1,082 secured self-storage units, up to 37,000 square feet of ground floor and second floor retail space, and a restaurant at the site facing Richmond Road. Cube Smart, the third largest self-storage owner in the country, will oversee day to day operations. The self-storage facility is projected to open in early 2019.

## Dollar General

Construction is underway at the intersection of Chardon Road and Richmond Road. Set to be completed in August 2018, the property is build-to-suit with a 15-year Corporate Guaranteed Lease with Dollar General. Dollar General is a publicly traded (NYSE: DG) Fortune 500 company that operates over 14,609 locations nationwide with a net worth of over four billion, and currently holds an investment grade credit rating of BBB-/Stable with S&P.

## Greenwood Farm Sanitary Sewer Project
