2. Print a hard copy of the [Complaint Form](#) which requires you to have the Form notarized.

4. Pick up a Complaint Form directly from the Board of Revision Office at 2079 E. 9th St. 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Cleveland, Ohio 44115.
