ALERT: UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS FRAUD

The Auditor of State’s Office has received a high volume of complaints from Ohioans that a fraudulent unemployment claim has been filed in their name or using their identifying information. If you believe your identity has been stolen & used to file an unemployment claim visit this link; unemployment.ohio.gov, click on the “Report Identity Theft” button, & complete the reporting form provided by the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services.
