A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF GREENEWIT GOVERNMENT CONTRACTING, LLC, D/B/A GC CONTRACTING, FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR PROFESSIONAL ENERGY AUDIT SERVICES UNDER THE MUNICIPAL ENERGY PROGRAM GRANT; AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, bids were received at the Office of the Director of Finance of the City for professional services for an energy audit through the Cuyahoga County Municipal Energy Program Grant with such work to be performed in accordance with the specifications prepared therefor and on file in the Department of Finance; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid received for said professional services was by Greenewit Government Contracting LLC, d/b/a GC Contracting, in the amount of \$17,685.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The bid of Greenewit Government Contracting, LLC, d/b/a GC Contracting, in the amount of \$17,685.00 for the City's bid specifications for professional services for an energy audit of City facilities under the Cuyahoga County Municipal Energy Program grant being the lowest and best bid received for such labor and materials be, and the same is hereby, accepted and approved; and the Mayor and Finance Director of the City are authorized to execute and enter into on behalf of the City a proper contract for said professional services in accordance with the specifications.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution from the Municipal Energy Program grant funds.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
