*A Resolution of Condolence Upon the Passing of Albertine Hoover
and in Appreciation for Her Service to the Community.*

Whereas the City of Richmond Heights is saddened by the news of the passing of Albertine (“Al”) Hoover on May 17, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Albertine was a very prominent volunteer in many community organizations throughout her lifetime, having lived in Richmond Heights since 1959; and

WHEREAS, Albertine became a Richmond Heights Local School Board Member in the early 1960s and was so well respected that she was elected as the first female school board president in the state of Ohio; she actively participated in the Boosters Club, Kiwanis Home Days, Parent Teacher Association, presided over voting precincts in the City, and served as Secretary of the Garden Club, member of the Richmond Heights American Legion Post 775 Ladies Auxiliary, member and chair of the Richmond Heights Senior Club, volunteer for Ohio Reads at the Elementary School, a member of St. John of the Cross Catholic Church (formerly St. Felicitas), and in many other capacities, unselfishly working to make the community she loved a better place for everyone;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: On behalf of the citizens of Richmond Heights, Mayor Daniel J. Ursu and this Council do hereby express their most sincere condolences to the family of Albertine Hoover and their most sincere appreciation for her outstanding service to the Richmond Heights community.
