WHEREAS, each of those persons will remain in our hearts forever and our thoughts will forever be with Newtown, Connecticut, as the memory of those lost in the December 14, 2012 tragedy will live on in not only the families who have suffered this extreme loss, but the world in which the shattered dreams and aspirations of those so dearly taken have been forever lost; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights, Ohio wishes to express its most sincere condolences and to extend its prayers to the families of the victims and all residents of Newtown, Connecticut, who will forever remain in our memory;
