

ORDINANCE NO.: 51 - 2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 141.29 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE CITY TO PROVIDE FOR FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR SERVICES OF THE DIVISION OF POLICE RELATED TO THE USE OF MARKED CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLES .

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety and the Chief of Police has recommended that the City add a fee under Section 141.29 for the use of Division of Police vehicles by persons or companies in conjunction with secondary employment requests.

WHEREAS, various companies and contractors perform work in the City that can be disruptive to vehicle traffic on public streets and highways and therefore can present a danger to motorists and workers alike, will request to hire off duty police officers to provide a traffic control function, and

WHEREAS, to further provide for the safety of motorists and workers will request that a Division of Police vehicle with emergency lights be present on the site of the work;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the council of the City of Richmond Heights, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio; that:

Section 1. Codified Ordinance Section 141.29, Fees For Services of Division of Police be amended to hereinafter read as follows:

141.29 FEES FOR SERVICES OF DIVISION OF POLICE

The Director of Public Safety is authorized to establish a fee schedule to be charged to persons for the following services and functions provided by the Division of Police:


- (a) Fingerprinting requested by an individual;
- (b) Authorization of release of a vehicle impounded by the Division of Police;
- (c) The use of marked Division of Police emergency vehicles by off duty Richmond Heights Police Officers or Auxiliary Officers while performing traffic control functions in the City for private companies and/or contractors.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force and after the earliest period allowed by law.


