A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING COSTS OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH, AND REFUSE AT RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS WITHIN THE CITY TO THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER FOR PLACEMENT ON THE TAX DUPLICATE AND COLLECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has reported to Council the estimated total collection costs and projected fees for collection and disposal of garbage, rubbish, and refuse collection for certain residential dwellings in the City for year 2015, in accordance with Section 951.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Richmond Heights, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to certify said collection and disposal costs to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer for placement on the tax duplicate of the applicable parcels of land and for collection as other taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The costs listed in Attachment "A" hereto, which is made a part hereof for all purposes, for the collection and disposal of garbage, rubbish, and refuse for year 2015 is certified to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer for the purpose of making the same a lien upon such lots in the City of Richmond Heights, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, to be collected as are other taxes and returned to the General Fund of the City of Richmond Heights pursuant to Section 951.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Richmond Heights.

Section 2: The Clerk of Council and the Director of Finance are authorized to prepare and submit all necessary documents to accomplish the required written return to the County Fiscal Officer in a timely manner.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Richmond Heights for the reason of the necessity to certify said fees to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer as soon as possible; and, therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
