A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR FOUR (4) TASER STUN DEVICES FROM VANCE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPLY FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has authorized the purchase of four (4) Taser Stun Devices from Vance's Law Enforcement Supply in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$6,050.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Vance's Law Enforcement Supply in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$6,050.00), to be paid from the Law Enforcement Supply Fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare of the City to immediately allow for the purchase of the devices. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force effective immediately, after its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor.
