

RESOLUTION NO.: 97 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TOM BROWN FOR REMOVAL OF A TREE IN RICHMOND PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a tree in Richmond Park is dead, must be removed, and is too large for Service Department personnel to remove; and

WHEREAS, Tom Brown has the skill and ability to remove the tree from Richmond Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Tom Brown to remove a tree from Richmond Park at a cost of nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950.00) to be paid from the general fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Richmond Heights for the reason that is necessary to immediately provide for the necessary tree removal, and therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor.
