A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GREENWOOD FARM ASSOCIATION TO PURSUE AN APPLICATION FOR DESIGNATION OF GREENWOOD FARM AS A HISTORICAL SITE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Greenwood Farm Association has requested the City of Richmond Heights to authorize and support an application for designation of Greenwood Farm as a historical site; and

WHEREAS, Greenwood Farm is an important landmark in the City and is deserving of the City's support in its application for designation as a historical site, and any funds necessary for the application for historical designation will come from the Greenwood Farm Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council, on behalf of the City of Richmond Heights, supports the Board of Directors the Greenwood Farm Association, and authorizes the Board to pursue application for designation of Greenwood Farm as a historical site. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any document necessary to assist in the application to designate Greenwood Farm as a historical site, subject to the approval of the Director of Law as necessary.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
