

RESOLUTION NO.: 118 -2014
INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR ROCHE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH TO PERFORM STORM WATER INSPECTION AND MONITORING SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City is required to monitor storm sewer outfall locations for purposes of analyzing the content of the storm water and to source track for possible sources of illicit discharges into the storm water; and

WHEREAS, the City does not have the expertise to provide such monitoring and inspections and has determined that the Cuyahoga County District Board of Health has such expertise, has provided these services to the City over the past seven years, and it is necessary to contract with the Board of Health for such services to cover the calendar years 2014 and 2015 and to provide for the costs thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into agreements with the Cuyahoga County District Board of Health for storm water inspection and monitoring services for calendar years 2014 and 2015, for a total cost to the City of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
