

ORDINANCE NO.: 51 -2015

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 79-2013 TO ADD TWO (2) ADDITIONAL PART-TIME EMPLOYEES TO THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT, CHANGE THE CLASSIFICATION FROM SUMMER TO SEASONAL, ADD THREE (3) ADDITIONAL SEASONAL EMPLOYEES AND ADJUSTING THE TERMS OF RECREATION BOARD MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to add two additional part-time employees to the Service Department and change the classification of “Summer” to “Seasonal” for part-time employees, add three Seasonal part-time employees in the Service Department, and clarify the terms of compensation for Recreation Board Members.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 79-2013, the Pay Ordinance of the City, is amended to add two (2) additional part-time employees to the Service Department as follows:

“Section 6: BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

Recreation Board

ASEx 6 – Members

\$25.00 per day meeting
(maximum of one meeting per month).

Section 9: DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND PROPERTIES.

PHNEx 8 <u>10</u> – Part-time Laborer (Unskilled)	\$7.95 - \$15.23 per hour (2014)
	\$7.95 - \$15.53 per hour (2015)

PHNEx 25 - Summer <u>Seasonal</u> Part-time Labor	\$7.95 - \$13.47 per hour (2014)
	\$7.95 - \$13.74 per hour (2015)

Section 2. Ordinance No. 79-2013 is repealed to the extent it is modified by this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City in that it is required to immediately provide for the additional employees and change classification, and further for the purpose of continued operation of the municipal government and the continuation of necessary City services. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force effective immediately, after its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor.
