

RESOLUTION NO. 24 -2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR A NEW FIRE CHIEF VEHICLE FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE.

WHEREAS, Council has authorized cooperative purchasing through the competitive bids obtained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Chief of Fire have advised this Council that the City is in need of a new fire chief vehicle, the purchase of which can be made through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program, in an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Council's Committee has reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommend the same, and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of the vehicle through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program from Lebanon Ford, Lebanon, Ohio in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Lebanon Ford, Lebanon, Ohio, for the purchase of one (1) 2016 Ford Explorer 4 door AWD Sport Utility Vehicle, for a total cost not to exceed \$30,000, pursuant to the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the amount deemed necessary to cover the cost of the new vehicle.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
