

RESOLUTION NO.: 17 -2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREAT LAKES RECYCLING, INC., DBA SIMPLE RECYCLING OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, FOR THE CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF SOFT RECYCLING MATERIALS IN THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights has identified a need to provide its residents with an alternative for the recycling and disposal of soft recyclables to reduce materials taken to landfills; and

WHEREAS, the City has learned about Simple Recycling, an entity that provides curbside services to identify, collect, haul, recycle and/or dispose of soft recyclables at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, the administration and Council wish to encourage the recycling of soft materials as a way to reduce the cost of use of landfills; and

WHEREAS, the collection of soft recyclables by Simple Recycling will also provide revenue to the City; and

WHEREAS, providing residents of the City with an option for disposal of soft recyclables is in the best interest of the City and the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement for the collection of soft recyclables with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc., dba Simple Recycling, and Council urges the residents of the City to fully participate in this program.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
