A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE AN IN-VEHICLE VIDEO SYSTEM FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

Whereas, the Division of Police has requested, and the Council's Safety and Finance Committees have recommended, the purchase of a digital in-vehicle video system for a new police vehicle being purchased at a cost not to exceed \$5,020.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with for the purchase of one (1) Watchguard 4RE Digital In-Car Video System from Watchguard , Inc., 415 Century Parkway, Allen, Texas, for the Division of Police at a cost not to exceed \$5,020.00.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
