**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
A PURCHASE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO
DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES'
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR A CALL
LOGGER FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.**

Whereas, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program and the Charter of the City authorizes such purchases; and

Whereas, the Police Chief has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of a call logger, the purchase of which can be made through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program for \$12,995.00; and

Whereas, Council's Safety and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for the call logger, and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of a Dynamic Instruments Vault II Call Logger through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program, from Stephen Campbell and Associates, of Beachwood, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Stephen Campbell and Associates, of Beachwood, Ohio, for the purchase of a Dynamic Instruments Vault II Call Logger for the Division of Police at a cost not to exceed \$12,995.00, under State Contract Index STS066, Contract No. 800358, as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to Fund 401 the amount of \$12,995.00 to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
