

RESOLUTION NO.: 10 -2016
INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Roche

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS IN 2016 TO SELL BY INTERNET AUCTION PERSONAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND OTHER PROPERTY REFERENCED IN REVISED CODE §721.15 WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE OR ARE OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH THEY WERE ACQUIRED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Revised Code §721.15 authorizes this Council to adopt a resolution to authorize the sale by internet auction of personal property owned by the City, including motor vehicles, and other personal property equipment referenced in Revised Code §721.15 which are no longer needed for public use or obsolete or unfit for the use for which they were acquired; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to adopt such a Resolution expressing its intent to sell the property by internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with GovDeals.com, Inc. to conduct such internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Clerk to advertise in a newspaper of general circulation a notice of intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property by internet auction; and

WHEREAS, this Council further wishes to authorize the Clerk to post notice of the intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property on the City's website throughout the year 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council adopts this Resolution for the purpose of expressing its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property by internet auction. The internet auction shall be conducted by GovDeals.com, Inc. Pursuant to Revised Code §721.15, the number of days for bidding on the property shall be no less than fifteen (15) days.

Section 2: Pursuant to Revised Code §721.15, the Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to publish notice of this Resolution in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.

Section 3: This Council further authorizes and directs the Clerk to publish a notice of this Resolution on the City's website during the year 2016.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to allow for the sale of unneeded City equipment at the earliest possible time; therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of five members of the Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
