

RESOLUTION NO.: 54 -2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS TO OFFICE TEAM FOR THE
CITY'S TEMPORARY STAFFING NEEDS.

WHEREAS, on two occasions (Resolution Nos. 96-2014, adopted on 10/14/14, and 7-2016, adopted on 3/8/16) this Council authorized agreements with outside staffing agencies, including Office Team, for the specialized temporary staffing needs of the City administration caused by the resignations of certain permanent City employees and to do so until permanent employees could be hired to fill those vacant positions; and

WHEREAS, one experienced person supplied by those staffing agencies filled those staffing needs for more than one administrative position from the latter part of 2014 through the early part of 2016 which provided consistency and efficiency to the administrative workforce at a cost equal to or less than what would have been expended for permanent employees and for which there were more than adequate appropriations of Council to cover such costs; and

WHEREAS, through inadvertence, payments to Office Team exceeded the amount in the original contract as authorized by Council and the current contract with Office Team was not authorized by Council until March 2016; and, therefore, this Council wishes to formally authorize payments made to Office Team in 2015 and early 2016 and to authorize payment of the amount of \$637.64 that is still due and owing for services rendered in February 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: An amount not to exceed \$10,240.00 is hereby authorized for the payments made to Office Team for temporary staffing services for 2015 through March 7, 2016.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
