

RESOLUTION NO.: 56 -2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PROFESSIONAL BUSINESS SYSTEMS, INC. FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE FILE SYSTEMS FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City enter into an agreement for maintenance of the file systems for the Division of Police; and

WHEREAS, Professional Business Systems, Inc. has provided the required services and can continue to do so for an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars and 50/100 (\$978.50).

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Professional Business Systems, Inc. for maintenance of the file systems for the Division of Police in an amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars and 50/100 (\$978.50).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
