

RESOLUTION NO.: 69 -2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS TO PURCHASE A SOFTWARE UPGRADE REQUIRED TO INTERFACE WITH THE REGIONAL INCOME TAX AGENCY'S SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City currently uses Software Solutions' "E-Gov" software provided through the Regional Income Tax Agency (RITA) to interface with RITA's system; and

WHEREAS, Software Solutions' "E-Gov" software is being replaced with its upgraded "VIP" software which is not available through RITA; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to continue to use Software Solutions software and to upgrade to the "VIP" software to provide better continuity between existing and new information; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance received one other quote from a software vendor, but that product does not meet the City's needs or provide the needed continuity of information; and

WHEREAS, the sole source of the "VIP" software upgrade is Software Solutions; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the purchase of the "VIP" software upgrade from Software Solutions in an amount not to exceed Ninety-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$98,500.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Software Solutions to purchase the "VIP" software upgrade at a cost not to exceed Ninety-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$98,500.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.


Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
