

RESOLUTION NO.: 71 -2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BASAR CONSTRUCTION FOR MASONRY REPAIRS OF THE FRONT AND REAR STEPS OF THE HOUSE AT GREENWOOD FARM.

WHEREAS, the Service Director of Public Service has obtained a quote from Basar Construction for the repair of the front and rear steps of the house at Greenwood Farm, specifically to rebuild the side wing walls of the front and back steps, reusing the bricks from an original wall at the Farm and using high-strength mortar to match existing mortar, and to install an 8"x12"x 6" concrete masonry units and pavers to match those elements existing at the front steps; and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Basar Construction for the repair of the front and rear steps of the house at Greenwood Farm in an amount not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$13,500.00); and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Basar Construction to repair the front and rear steps of the house at Greenwood Farm in an amount not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$13,500.00).

NOW, THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Basar Construction to repair the front and rear steps of the house at Greenwood Farm as set forth in the recitals to this Resolution for a cost not to exceed Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$13,500.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
