A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WEATHERPROOFING TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR ASBESTOS TESTING ON PORTIONS OF THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT GARAGE ROOF.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has obtained a quote from Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc. (hereinafter "WTI") for asbestos testing, specifically to extract four (4) cores on designated areas of the Service Department garage roof and perform an asbestos test; and

WHEREAS, the asbestos testing must be done before necessary roof work can be performed on the Service Department garage; and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with WTI for the asbestos testing described above in an amount not to exceed One Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$1,370.00); and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with WTI for the asbestos testing described above in an amount not to exceed One Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$1,370.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with WTI for the asbestos testing described in the recitals of this Resolution for a cost not to exceed One Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$1,370.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
