**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREEN VISION MATERIALS, INC. FOR THE DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights is in need of a facility at which to dispose of curbside collected yard waste for the period of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Green Vision Materials, Inc. has previously provided facilities at which the City can dispose of yard waste collected by the City and the current agreement between the City and Green Vision Materials, Inc. will expire on August 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties received a quote from Green Vision Materials, Inc. to continue to provide the City with a facility to dispose of curbside collected yard waste for the period of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018 in an amount not to exceed Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00); and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Green Vision Materials, Inc. to provide for a facility to dispose of curbside collected yard waste for the period of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2018 in an amount not to exceed Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Green Vision Materials, Inc. to provide for a facility to dispose of curbside collected yard waste for the period of September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2018 at a cost not to exceed Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00) to be paid from the General Fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
