

RESOLUTION NO.: 111 -2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH COLLINS EQUIPMENT CORP. TO REMOVE WATER FROM THE CITY'S DIESEL AND GASOLINE STORAGE TANKS.

WHEREAS, water has built up in the City's diesel and gasoline storage tanks and must be removed and a biocide added to prevent bacteria from forming; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has obtained a quote from Collins Equipment Corp. to pump the water out of the storage tanks and to add a biocide for a cost not to exceed One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$1,835.00); and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Collins Equipment Corp. for the work described above in an amount not to exceed One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$1,835.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Collins Equipment Corp. to remove water from the City's diesel and gasoline storage tanks and add a biocide for a cost not to exceed One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$1,835.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
