A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MOONLIGHT POOLS FOR REPAIRS TO THE CITY POOL.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has obtained a quote for fiberglass and stair repairs to the City's swimming pool in the City Park in the amount of Thirteen Thousand five Hundred Dollars (\$13,500.00);

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into the proposed agreement with Moonlight Pools for the Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred Dollars but for Council to authorize by this Resolution an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) to cover the expense of any unexpected additional need for repairs to the pool that may be found during the performance of the work; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into the aforesaid agreement in an amount not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Moonlight Pools for repairs to the City pool at a cost not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).

Section 2: To the extent necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
