A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FROM THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CITY'S KIWANIS LODGE.

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Department of Development offers Community Development Block Grants in amounts of up to \$150,000.00 for municipal projects that strengthen cities and improve the quality of life for residents;

WHEREAS, the City applied for a Community Development Block Grant to make improvements to its Kiwanis Lodge community facility, specifically to upgrade restroom facilities;

WHEREAS, the City was one of twelve suburbs awarded a Community Development Block Grant and will receive \$150,000.00 to make improvements at the Kiwanis Lodge; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to accept this grant and to authorize the Mayor to execute any agreements and other documents necessary to receive the grant monies.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City accepts the Community Development Block Grant from the Cuyahoga County Department of Development in the amount of \$150,000.00 for improvements at the City's Kiwanis Lodge and further authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements and other documents necessary to receive the grant monies.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
