A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION TO THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS DIVISION OF FIRE FROM UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS OF EIGHT (8) AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$17,000 FOR THE USE BY PUBLIC SAFETY FORCES AND EXPRESSING ITS MOST SINCERE GRATITUDE TO UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS.

WHEREAS, to support the City's initiative to provide safe, effective, and efficient services to the community, the goal of the City of Richmond Heights is to equip all public safety vehicles with Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs) and to train all public safety employees, especially first responders, in the proper use of the device;

WHEREAS, the City's Division of Fire, has received a generous donation of eight (8) Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs) from University Hospitals Richmond Medical Center valued at approximately \$17,000; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to accept said donation and to express the City's thanks to University Hospitals for such a generous donation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Richmond Heights the donation of eight (8) Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs) from University Hospitals Richmond Medical Center.

Section 2: On behalf of the entire Council, the Mayor, City public safety forces, and Richmond Heights citizens, most sincere thanks and gratitude is given to University Hospitals for such a generous donation.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
