A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH B&C COMMUNICATIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BI-DIRECTIONAL AMPLIFIER FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Police Department needs a bi-directional amplifier due to the City's transitioning to a new dispatch center and a different radio frequency; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has received a quote from B&C Communications for the purchase and installation of one (1) bi-directional amplifier for the Division of Police at the Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$14,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Council's Safety and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommend the same to Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with B&C Communications for the purchase and installation of one (1) bi-directional amplifier for the Division of Police at the police department in an amount not to exceed \$14,000.00.

Section 2: If it is necessary to do so, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchases referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
