

RESOLUTION NO.: 122 -2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TOTAL LINE REFRIGERATION, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN ICE MAKER AND RELATED WORK AT THE CITY'S KIWANIS LODGE.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has obtained a quote from Total Line Refrigeration, Inc. to sell and install an ice maker (Manitowoc SPA-160 dispensing bin and Manitowoc IYT-0420A ice machine) with related work at the Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$5,350.00); and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Total Line Refrigeration, Inc. for the ice maker (Manitowoc SPA-160 dispensing bin and Manitowoc IYT-0420A ice machine) and related installation work at the Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$5,350.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Total Line Refrigeration, Inc. for the purchase and installation of an ice maker (Manitowoc SPA-160 dispensing bin and Manitowoc IYT-0420A ice machine) and related work at the City's Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$5,350.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement referred to in Section 1 above from the City's Fund No. 401.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
