**A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE RE-APPOINTMENT BY THE
MAYOR OF MICHAEL E. MARCUM AS A MEMBER OF THE
ARCHITECTURAL BOARD OF REVIEW OF THE CITY OF
RICHMOND HEIGHTS.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Richmond Heights, in accordance with Codified Ordinance 154.01, has authority to appoint a member of the City's Architectural Board of Review ("ABR") for the term set forth herein and the ordinance requires Council to confirm such appointments;

WHEREAS, due to the resignation of Anthony Green from the ABR it was necessary to fill Mr. Green's unexpired term ending December 31, 2018, and the Mayor appointed and this Council confirmed the appointment of Michael E. Marcum to fill that term;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has re-appointed Mr. Marcum to the ABR for a new term commencing January 1, 2019 and seeks confirmation of this Council to that re-appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor's re-appointment of the following named individual for a full term on the Architectural Board of Review set forth herein is confirmed by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights:

Michael E. Marcum - term commencing January 1, 2019 and expiring December 31, 2021.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
