A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR TWO (2) POLICE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program and the Charter of the City authorizes such purchases;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of two (2) patrol vehicles, the purchase of which can be made from a vendor who will sell the vehicles at less than the price established by the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program and will be \$31,692.80 per vehicle and there will be an additional cost to properly outfit the vehicles for patrol use at \$3,766.00 each for the two model year 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV 4X4 vehicles for a total cost of \$35,458.80 each;

WHEREAS, Council's Safety and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for the vehicles and recommends the purchases thereof; and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of the vehicles from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc. in Warrensville Heights, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement for the purchase of two (2) model year 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe PPV 4X4 vehicles from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc. in Warrensville Heights, Ohio at a total cost not to exceed \$70,917.60, said price being lower than the State contract amounts as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
