A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LOCATION CARPET INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF NEW FLOOR COVERINGS AT THE CITY'S KIWANIS LODGE AND AT CITY HALL.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties obtained price quotations from various vendors of floor coverings for the City's Kiwanis Lodge and City Hall and Location Carpet Inc. was the lowest quotation to sell and install floor coverings at the Lodge and City Hall in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000.00);

WHEREAS, Council's Finance Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Location Carpet Inc. for the aforesaid purchase and installation of floor coverings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Location Carpet Inc. for the purchase and installation of floor coverings at the City's Kiwanis Lodge and City Hall in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000.00).

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate from the Capital Fund a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
