

RESOLUTION NO.: 104-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WATCHGUARD FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO VEHICLE CAMERAS FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of two vehicle dashboard cameras for two new police patrol vehicles, the purchase and installation of which can be made from a company known as WatchGuard;

Whereas, Council's Safety and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for the cameras and recommended the purchase and installation thereof from WatchGuard, and to authorize the expenditure therefor not to exceed \$11,000.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with WatchGuard for the purchase and installation of two dash cameras for two new Division of Police patrol vehicles for a total cost not to exceed \$11,000.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
