

RESOLUTION NO. 124 -2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT AND THE CUYAHOGA SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT FOR A CONSERVATION PROGRAM INVOLVING EDUCATION, STEWARDSHIP AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights has and must continue to possess a municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) permit which includes the requirement by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to have a storm water management plan and that plan includes a soil and water conservation program with a public involvement and public education component;

WHEREAS, for 2020, the Cuyahoga Soil & Water Conservation District ("SWCD"), with the assistance and support of the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District ("NEORS"), have offered to assist the City to provide the conservation program to include public involvement, public education and stewardship related to storm water drainage issues necessary to meet Ohio Environmental Protection Agency regulations;

WHEREAS, NEORS has agreed to pay SWCD for these service being performed for the City in the amount of \$5,500.


NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between the Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District for provision of the conservation program services to the City as set forth in the recitals to this Resolution in calendar year 2020 in the amount of \$5,500, which amount is to be reimbursed to the City by NEORS.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
