A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WATCHGUARD VIDEO FOR THE PROVISION OF TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE UPGRADES FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of upgrades to its wifi and cloud technology;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has obtained a proposal dated March 11, 2021 from WatchGuard Video for the provision of the needed technology upgrades and services for a total cost of \$20,410;

WHEREAS, Council's Safety Committee and Finance Committee have reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommend the same to Council and Council desires to authorize the purchase from WatchGuard Video for an amount not to exceed \$20,410;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with WatchGuard Video for the purchase of wifi and cloud technology upgrades of equipment and service for an amount not to exceed \$20,410;

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
