**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND THREAT ASSESSMENT TRAINING GRANTS FROM THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General has granted to the City of Richmond Heights two (2) Threat Assessment Training Grants ("Grants") in the amount of \$500 each for a total of \$1,000 to provide training to the staff of the Division of Police;

WHEREAS, this Council determines that acceptance of the Grants is in the best interests of the City in furthering the health, safety and welfare of its citizens through enhancement of its Police Division's training efforts;


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to take such required actions as are necessary to accept the Grants from the Ohio Attorney General and to expend the funds for the provision of Threat Assessment Training for the staff of the Division of Police.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
