

RESOLUTION NO.: 15 -2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CRASH COURSE VILLAGE FOR ROPE RESCUE OPERATIONS TRAINING FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 77-2020, passed by Council on August 25, 2020, the City accepted a U.S. Department of Homeland Security "Assistance to Firefighters Grant" (the "Grant") in the amount of \$44,000 for the purpose of purchasing rope rescue equipment, classroom instruction, "hands on" training and staffing expenses for Division of Fire personnel to attend the training;

WHEREAS, the City has received a proposal from Crash Course Village, a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization providing quality, hands-on training for fire and rescue teams, to provide eight (8) days of training sessions on Rope Rescue Operations for the City's Division of Fire personnel for the amount of six thousand five hundred dollars (\$6,500.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Crash Course Village, 2685 Culver Avenue, Kettering, Ohio 45429, to provide Rope Rescue Operations Training to Division of Fire personnel for a total cost not to exceed \$6,500.00.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
