

RESOLUTION NO.: 41-2021
INTRODUCED BY: All of Council

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF STREET LIGHTING ON VARIOUS STREETS IN THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS.

WHEREAS, as a needed budget-cutting measure in or about 2012, the City of Richmond Heights shuttered or eliminated street lights on certain streets in the City;

WHEREAS, with additional funds available in 2021 and for increased public safety and security reasons, this Council and the Mayor have determined to re-establish a total of seventy-nine street lights on the following streets in the City:

Chardon Road;
Richmond Road;
Highland Road;
Trebisky Road;
Monticello Boulevard; and
Wilson Mills Road;

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that to carry out the directive in this Resolution, there may need to be a supplemental appropriation to the City's approved budget appropriations for 2021 and that a supplemental appropriation ordinance will be submitted to this Council therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized and directed to cause the re-establishment of a total of seventy-nine (79) street lights on the City streets set forth in the recitals to this Resolution and to do so within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 2: If necessary for the funding of the action authorized and directed in Section 1 of this Resolution, the Director of Finance is directed to forthwith prepare a supplemental appropriation ordinance for this Council's consideration for passage.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
