**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY SERVICES-WARREN FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROPE RESCUE EQUIPMENT FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.**

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 77-2020, passed by Council on August 25, 2020, the City accepted a U.S. Department of Homeland Security "Assistance to Firefighters Grant" (the "Grant") in the amount of \$44,000 for the purpose of purchasing rope rescue equipment, classroom instruction, "hands on" training, and staffing expenses for Division of Fire personnel to attend the training;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire has received a quote from Municipal Emergency Services-Warren Fire Equipment for the purchase of rope rescue equipment in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), which was the lowest of four quotes;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Municipal Emergency Services-Warren Fire Equipment, 6880 Tod Avenue SW, Warren, Ohio 44481, for the purchase of rope rescue equipment for the Division of Fire at a cost not to exceed \$10,000.00, in accordance with the quote from Emergency Services-Warren Fire Equipment attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
