A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A  
COMMUNITY COST-SHARE AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTHEAST  
OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT FOR FUNDING OF THE CITY-WIDE  
STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-2016, passed April 12, 2016, the City of Richmond Heights entered into a Regional Stormwater Management Program Service Agreement with Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District ("NEORS" or the "District");

WHEREAS, as part of the Regional Stormwater Management Program, NEORS manages a Community Cost Share account which provides funding to assist the City with District-approved projects;

WHEREAS, the District has approved the City's City-Wide Storm Water Management Program for 2021 in the amount of \$42,500, as a Community Cost Share project, and the District will allocate the total sum of \$42,500 in Community Cost Share funds for this project; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into a Community Cost-Share Agreement with NEORS so that Community Cost-Share funds can be utilized for the City's project described above.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a Community Cost-Share Agreement with NEORS to receive the sum of \$42,500 in Community Cost-Share funds to use for the City's City-Wide Storm Water Management Program for 2021, which shall include such terms as are acceptable to the Director of Law.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
