A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH HALL PUBLIC SAFETY UPFITTERS FOR UPFITTING EQUIPMENT FOR THREE NEW POLICE VEHICLES AT A COST AT OR BELOW THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM BID PRICING FOR EQUIVALENT UPFITTING EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program and purchases from vendors offering pricing at or below State Purchasing Program bid pricing;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of upfitting equipment for its three (3) new Chevrolet Tahoe police vehicles, the purchase of which was authorized by Resolution No. 40-2021 of this Council;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has received a proposal from Hall Public Safety Upfitters, 8291 Darrow Road, Twinsburg, Ohio 44087, for upfitting equipment for the three (3) new police vehicles for the amount of \$37,632.56, which is at or below the State Cooperative Purchasing Program price for the equivalent upfitting equipment for police cruiser vehicles;

WHEREAS, Council's Public Safety Committee has reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommends the same to Council;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the procurement from Hall Public Safety Upfitters for the purchase of equipment and labor to install on the three new (3) police vehicles for the amount of \$37,632.56, which is priced at or below the State Cooperative Purchasing Program bid price for the equivalent upfitting equipment for police cruiser vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement for the purchase and installation of upfitting equipment for three (3) new police vehicles from Hall Public Safety Upfitters at a cost not to exceed \$37,632.56, as set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
