

RESOLUTION NO.: 60 - 2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HIGHPOINT TREE SERVICE FOR TREE REMOVAL AND STUMP-GRINDING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Public Service has advised that it is necessary to remove 23 ash trees on Chardon Road, 5 ash trees on Audrey Drive, 8 ash trees on Steven Boulevard, and 6 ash trees on Snavelly Road;

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Public Service has obtained a quote for the removal of the above-referenced ash trees from Highpoint Tree Service, Mayfield Heights, Ohio, 44124;

WHEREAS, the quote of Highpoint Tree Service in the amount of \$13,900.00 for the removal of 42 ash trees includes chipping of wood and brush, which will be hauled away, and the grinding of 42 ash stumps to approximately 8 inches below grade;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Highpoint Tree Service for the removal of 42 ash trees, as set forth in the recitations above, for an amount not to exceed \$13,900.00.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said agreement referred to in Section 1 above.


Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
