

RESOLUTION NO.: 70 -2021

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
CONTRACT WITH MR. LEVEL CONCRETE LEVELING FOR
REPAIRS OF THE CITY PARK GAZEBO FLOOR.**

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has advised this Council that the floor of the gazebo in the City Park has sunk and is in need of repair and the Director has received three (3) quotations for the repair work and Mr. Level Concrete Leveling is the lowest quotation for the work at \$5,500;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has recommended that this Council authorize the acceptance of the quotation submitted by Mr. Level Concrete Leveling and to enter into a contract with that company for the repair and this Council finds that the repair work is necessary and that entering into a contract with Mr. Level Concrete Leveling is appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Mr. Level Concrete Leveling for the repair work to the floor of the gazebo in the City Park for an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500.00).

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


