

## Noise Abatement Policy, Cuyahoga County Airport

The 2010 Joint Noise Abatement Statement established a policy that operators voluntarily limit flights in and out of the airport from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Due to FAA regulations, the Noise Abatement Policy is not mandatory. If you have a complaint about noise related to the airport, email the airport at [ccairport@cuyahogacounty.us](mailto:ccairport@cuyahogacounty.us), or call the airport directly at 216-289-4111. All noise complaints are logged, but in order for a noise complaint to be researched, the complaint must be submitted to the airport within 72 hours of the event. If this parameter is met, the airport begins research and then sends a written response upon conclusion of its research to both the local municipality and the individual who submitted the complaint. If it is determined that an aircraft operated during noise abatement hours, the airport will send a letter to the aircraft operator, notifying the operator of the complaint and reminding him or her of the Noise Abatement Program.

The Noise Abatement Council meets quarterly at the Cuyahoga County Airport Administration Building, located at 26400 Curtiss Wright Parkway in Richmond Heights. These meetings are open to the public.
