A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH AT&T FOR A DEDICATED INTERNET CONNECTION WITH AN AT&T MANAGED ROUTER.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has advised this Council that the City is in need of a dedicated internet connection, and that AT&T has submitted a proposal dated February 1, 2022 to provide to the City a one (1) gig dedicated internet connection with an AT&T managed router at a cost of \$2,311.60 per month for a term of 36 months;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into a utility service agreement with AT&T for a one (1) gig dedicated internet connection with an AT&T managed router at a cost of \$2,311.60 per month for a term of 36 months, subject to future years appropriations by Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a utility service agreement with AT&T for a one (1) gig dedicated internet connection with an AT&T managed router at a cost of \$2,311.60 per month for a term of 36 months, subject to annual appropriations by this Council, for a total cost not to exceed \$83,217.60, under such terms and conditions as are approved for legal form by the Director of Law.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.


