

RESOLUTION NO.: 14-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY DISPATCH FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Chagrin Valley Dispatch, a regional council of governments which also serves as the City's emergency dispatch center, has provided professional information technology support services to the City since September 15, 2021 under a trial basis agreement at a cost of \$3,000 per month, and that agreement is set to expire after February 15, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has advised this Council that the City is in need of continuing information technology support services on an immediate and as needed basis and is recommending the continued provision of those services by Chagrin Valley Dispatch, which has offered to provide continuing information technology support services at a cost of \$3,000 per month for a period of one year for a total amount not to exceed \$36,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Chagrin Valley Dispatch for the provision of information technology support services for the period of February 16, 2022 through February 15, 2023 at a cost of \$3,000 per month and a total cost not to exceed \$36,000.00, the contract for which shall be in a form substantially as set forth in the "Agreement to Provide Managed IT Services" attached hereto as Exhibit A and as approved for legal form and correctness by the Director of Law.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


