

RESOLUTION NO.: 27-2022

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY DISPATCH FOR THE PURCHASE OF WEARABLE CAMERAS, WIFI RADIO BASE, STANDARD CAR SYSTEMS, AND ASSOCIATED WARRANTIES, LICENSING, AND SOFTWARE, AND SET-UP AND TRAINING SERVICES FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised this Council that the City is in need of new wearable cameras, a WiFi radio base, and a standard car system for the Division of Police, and that Chagrin Valley Dispatch has provided a quote in the amount of \$24,600.00 for eight wearable WatchGuard cameras, one WiFi radio base, one standard car system and associated warranties, licensing and software, and set-up and training services;

WHEREAS, Council's Safety Committee has reviewed the need for the foregoing equipment and services and recommended the purchase of the same from Chagrin Valley Dispatch in an amount not to exceed \$24,600.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Chagrin Valley Dispatch for the purchase of eight wearable WatchGuard cameras, one WiFi radio base, one standard car system and associated warranties, licensing, and software, and set-up and training services, as set forth in its quote, for an amount not to exceed \$24,600.00.


